

Sunday, March 24, 8:00 and 10:15a (Outdoor Chapel, Sanctuary)

On the Feast of Palm Sunday, we commemorate Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem and the beginning of Holy Week. We begin the service by the cross in the Outdoor Chapel (weather permitting) with the Liturgy of the Palms and a procession of the faithful carrying palms, representing the palm branches the crowd scattered in front of Jesus as he rode into Jerusalem. The service continues with a reading of the Passion Narrative and the celebration of Holy Eucharist.
