

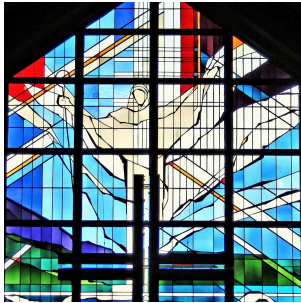

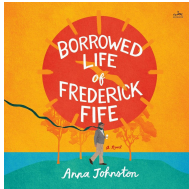
The Outreach Committee Thanks You Twice
