

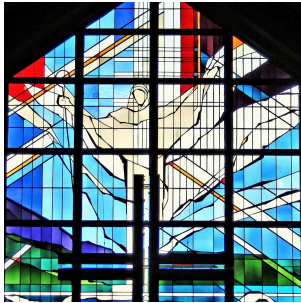

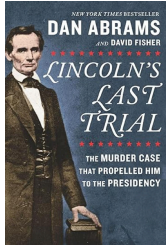
Start of Summer Kings Dominion Trip
